A free half-day event for theatre & performance venue staff, casual, part-time or freelance technicians in the entertainment industry and managers & directors of venues and arts centres.

Arranged by BECTU and the South West TUC’s Green Workplaces Project the session will look at ways of saving money and reducing carbon emissions. The events will be led by Martin Roberts, chief electrician at the Princess Theatre, Torquay and BECTU Learning Organiser. Martin is Project Manager of the Technical Workshops in Theatre Project and has been responsible for knocking nearly a thousand pounds annually off the Torquay venue electricity bill. Martin will be joined by a Green Workplaces Project Worker from the TUC.

At a time when climate change is a growing concern, and theatres are under increasing financial constraints, these sessions will offer practical solutions that can really make a difference, including the environmental and financial benefits of switching to low energy lighting systems, with positive examples and advice and guidance on which system is best for particular venues.

Lunch will also be provided at the close of each event.
